From the President

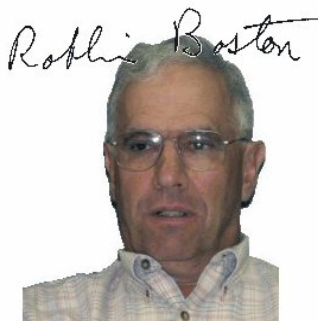

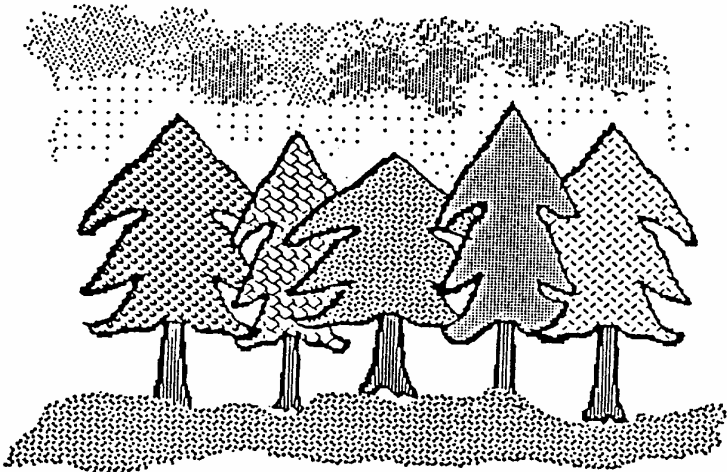

“Spying” on the Puget Sound Chapter...

Those chapter members who ventured south and attended the Puget Sound Chapter meeting enjoyed a presentation on “Spyware: The Newest Scourge of the Internet” by Chris Glanister of Pilgrim Media Services.

Chris defined the types of Spyware / Adware, how these nasties come to reside on your system or network, how they differ from a virus, and the tools you can use to banish them and restore your system performance.

Note: If you don’t think that it’s a very good idea to keep up on efforts to prevent getting your system loaded up with these programs, it typically takes about three hours of a technician time (read “billable hours”) to clean the average infected system.

9. If your plans were put into effect, would the results meet the stated goals of the organization?

14. Are you ready to become the “Champion” and push this project forward?

15. Are you going to take action, complain, or just quit?

11. How many other member could benefit from such a program?

I do expect to see some output... Somebody out there must have a need we're not meeting along with an idea of what it would take, and where we should start.

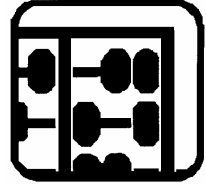
